Dear Parents,

Re: Infectious Illnesses

We wish to advise you that there are a number of students in our school community who attend school while recovering from or undergoing treatment.

As a consequence of their treatment, these students' ongoing health is at risk if they come into contact with an infectious illness, in particular chickenpox, measles or mumps. If your son is suspected of having one of these illnesses it is very important that he does not attend school. It is also important that whilst your son is unwell that he remains at home until he is no longer contagious. Information on infectious conditions can be found on the national health website www.health.gov.au or alternatively you can contact your local doctor.

If your child has chickenpox, measles or mumps or is suspected of having an illness please contact the school immediately. This will allow the school to assess the probable contact and therefore exposure of our students to the disease. Notification can then be given to their parents and medical specialists.
